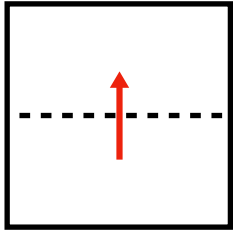

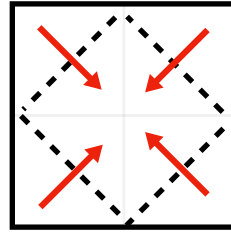
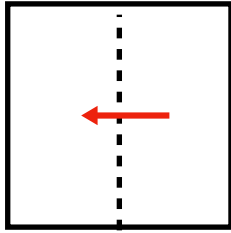
Instructions:

1. Cut out the provided "Fortune Teller." Use scissors to cut along the large exterior square and fold according to the instructions below. If you need help, there are plenty of videos online. Younger students will need additional support.
2. Once complete, use the "Fortune Teller" to help you activate your senses and explore the great outdoors.

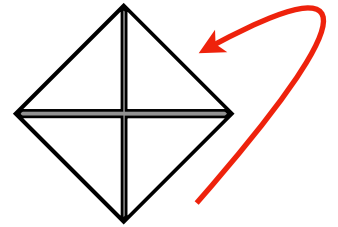
How to Fold the "Fortune Teller"



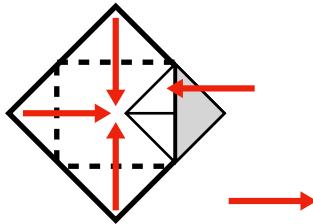
1. With the artwork face down, fold and unfold.



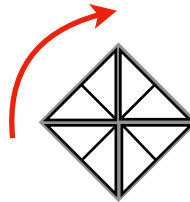
2. Fold each corner to the centre.



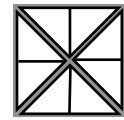
3. Keep folds together and flip over.



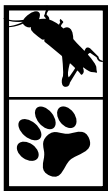
4. Fold each corner into the centre again.



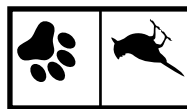
5. It should look like this. Rotate the fortune teller.



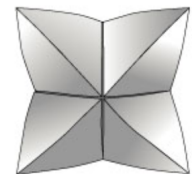
6. It should now look like this.



7. Fold along the vertical centre line.



8. Open. Then fold along the horizontal centre line.



9. Work your fingers and thumbs into the four corners and practise opening and closing the Fortune Teller.

How to Use:

1. Once you are comfortable operating the fortune teller, it is time to step outside and give it a try.
2. Select a picture. Spell out the name of the animal/object, opening/closing/opening the Fortune Teller for each letter. For example, the paw print could be "T-R-A-C-K or B-E-A-R."
3. Next, select a number. Work the Fortune Teller for each number in the count. Repeat this step once more.
4. Select a final number and open the corresponding triangle. Do as it says and have fun!
