
Sound Map

Year-Round Activity Grades K to 8

- 1. Find a quiet area in nature. Your backyard and local park can work if you can't get to a wilder area.
- 2. On a blank piece of paper draw a large circle. Draw a picture of yourself in the middle or an x
- 3. Add a compass rose.
- 4. Sit quietly for 10 to 15 minutes. Each time you hear a sound draw a picture of what made the sound from the direction the sound came from.
- 5. Visit the same area through the seasons or at different times of day and make a sound map each time. What do you notice about the sounds? Are their differences depending on the season or time of day? Are there more bird calls in the spring and early morning? etc.
