

Camp Kawartha Outreach COVID-19 Health Protocols

February 23, 2021

Staff Screening:

- Prior to arriving at a school, all Camp Kawartha staff will complete the self-screening tool as required by the Government of Ontario “COVID-19 School and Child Care”

- Camp Kawartha staff must have a negative COVID-19 screening test the day of programming. Each staff person will bring a copy of this completed negative test with them to present to the presiding teacher or principal.
- A copy will be filed electronically at Camp Kawartha and available for review when requested.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

- All Camp Kawartha instructors will be required to wear both a medical grade face mask as well as a face shield.
- All students will be required to wear a face covering for the duration of the program.
- Camp Kawartha staff will be required to bring the following equipment: 60% alcohol based hand sanitizer, cleaning - disinfectant solution, cloths and paper towels.

Program Equipment:

- All equipment used in a program will be cleaned and disinfected. Products used will be a Health Canada approved hard-surface disinfectant with evidence against COVID-19
- Any fabric items used will be single use and will be laundered prior to being brought back into programming.

Program Safety Practices:

- All students are required to use hand sanitizer before and after programming.
- Students will be encouraged to stay 2-metres apart. Teachers will support the implementation of this protocol.
- Any activity that involves tagging must use pool noodles, or other equipment that can be held at arm's length to ensure 2-metre distancing.
