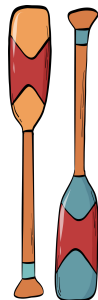

Canoe Trippers



Job Responsibilities:

- Leads canoe trips or day trips as assigned. In charge of all aspects of the day during trips including group navigation, safety, daily schedule, and mitigations response to emergency situations
- Ensure the safety of campers on trip and on site (includes safe food handling, water treatment, and safe campsites.)
- Exercises judgement about safe canoeing conditions
- Ensures the physical and emotional safety of campers and fellow staff while on trip and on site.
- Monitors camper's health, manages camper hygiene while on trip and on site.
- Conducts camper screening prior to trip to assess skills, ability and history .
- Creates a comfortable, respectful and fun tripping experience.
- Ensures packing, storing and timely ordering of food and supplies for trips.
- Assists tripping program in care, inventory and management of all tripping equipment and materials.

Requirements:

- Wilderness Advanced First Aid or Wilderness First Responder
- Current NL Certification
- Ability to live on site at Camp Kawartha for the duration of the summer
- Primary work period: June - August 2026
