Congratulations to Straworks for Winning First Place

Straworks won First Place in the Small Buildings Category at the Ontario Embodied Carbon Awards for their construction of the Camp Kawartha Rotary Health Centre. These awards



celebrate outstanding low embodied carbon projects across Ontario. Straworks calculated that the Camp Kawartha Rotary Health Centre **absorbs** 6.5 tonnes of carbon, making it a carbon negative build. A conventional building of the same size would emit 35 tonnes! Camp Kawartha is excited to promote education about sequestered carbon architecture!

- 4. Top with whipped cream (the extra room in the mug makes all the difference).




- 5. Level up with Meghan: Top with crushed candy cane, sparkles, chocolate shavings,
